<p><b>Reports to:</b> Ecology Director</p>		
<p><b>Objective:</b> To assist the Ecology Director in developing and executing a quality fishing program for all campers.</p>		
<p><b>Requirements for hire:</b> Have a general understanding of and ability to teach fishing skills to campers. Must be in good standing with the Boy Scouts of America, Conquistador Council, and Wehinahpay Mountain Camp.</p>		
<p><b>Preferences for hire:</b> Extensive experience with fishing and fly fishing.</p>		
<p><b>Specific Responsibilities:</b></p>		
<p>The Ecology Assistant Director – Fishing must have knowledge of conservative fishing practices and must be able to instruct these to campers. They will operate the Lake during scheduled merit badge classes, and at other times as directed by the Ecology Director. Specific responsibilities include:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Aid the Ecology Director in the supervision, and motivation of the Fishing Staff in all their activities.</li> <li>2. As assigned, aid the area director in the training of the Fishing Staff in all their activities.</li> <li>3. Assume full direction of the lakefront in the absence of the Ecology Director, unless otherwise instructed.</li> <li>4. Offer a quality fishing program which may include the Fishing and Fly Fishing merit badges and open fishing.</li> <li>5. Assist in the set-up and take-down of a quality lakefront instructional area and Ecology Area.</li> <li>6. Assist the Ecology Director in the maintenance, inventory, security, safety, and wise use of all Ecology Area equipment used in the fishing programs.</li> <li>7. Maintain strict discipline at all times when campers, leaders, and other staff are in the area.</li> <li>8. Participate in all camp-wide activities.</li> <li>9. Assist in the set-up and take-down of all camp facilities.</li> <li>10. All other duties as assigned.</li> </ol>
