<p><b>Requirements for hire:</b></p>	<p>Holds a Level I Instructor certification for COPE or climbing.* Must be in good standing with the Boy Scouts of America, Conquistador Council, and Wehinahpay Mountain Camp.</p>	
<p><b>Preferences for hire:</b></p>	<p>Holds a Level II Instructor certification for COPE. Previous climbing and COPE experience.</p>	
<p><b>Specific Responsibilities:</b></p>		
<p>The COPE/Climbing Assistant Director aids the COPE/Climbing Director in teaching the Climbing merit badge and Project C.O.P.E. skills to all participants, along with supervising the COPE/Climbing staff. Specific responsibilities include:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Aid the COPE/Climbing Director in the supervision and motivation of the COPE/Climbing Staff in all their activities.</li> <li>2. As assigned, aid the COPE/Climbing director in the training of the COPE/Climbing staff in all their activities.</li> <li>3. Assume full direction of the COPE/Climbing area in the absence of the COPE/Climbing Director, unless otherwise directed.</li> <li>4. Maintain the high standards of safety and program as set forth in the C.O.P.E. guidebook, Climb-On, and training.</li> <li>5. Offer a quality COPE/Climbing program that includes the Climbing Merit Badge and Project C.O.P.E. program.</li> <li>6. Assist in the set-up and take-down of the climbing tower, C.O.P.E. course, and Aerial Adventure Park under strict adherence to all National Standards regarding Project C.O.P.E. and climbing facilities.</li> <li>7. Assist the COPE/Climbing Director in the maintenance, inventory, security, safety, and wise use of all COPE/Climbing equipment used in the COPE/Climbing area.</li> <li>8. Maintain a strict discipline at all times when campers, leaders, and other staff are in the area.</li> <li>9. Participate in all camp-wide activities.</li> <li>10. Assist in the set-up and take-down of all camp facilities.</li> <li>11. All other duties as assigned.</li> </ol>
