<p>Reports to: Business Manager</p>		
<p>Objective: To provide for the health and safety needs of the camp, its campers, visitors, and its staff.</p>		
<p>Requirements for hire: Must be in compliance with the Boy Scouts of America's National Camp Accreditation Program Standard SQ-405 or is otherwise able to become compliant with the requirements before the start of the summer camp season.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The Camp Medic must be certified in American Red Cross Standard First Aid and CPR/AED for Professional Rescuers and Health Care Providers, or equivalent. - The Camp Medic must have a certified career in the medical field, and may require other certifications for hire. - The Camp Medic must also have a current certification in American Red Cross Wilderness and Remote first Aid, Emergency Care and Safety Institute Wilderness First Aid, or equivalent. <p>Must be in good standing with the Boy Scouts of America, Conquistador Council, and Wehinahpay Mountain Camp.</p>		
<p>Preferences for hire: Is age 25 of older with prior camp medical staff experience [RP-453].</p>		
<p>Specific Responsibilities:</p> <p>The Camp Medic alerts the Camp Director to any unsafe actions or conditions of the campers or camp – specific responsibilities include:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Be particularly alert to the conditions which affect health, safety, sanitation, and good housekeeping practices. 2. Direct the set-up and take-down of a quality Medic's Office. 3. Maintain strict discipline at all times when campers, leaders, and other staff are in the area. 4. Represent the Medical Staff at all meetings with camp administration. 5. Work in conjunction with the Council Medical Officer and local hospital. 6. Maintain a daily sick call and first aid treatment center. 7. Conduct the weekly medical recheck of each camper. 8. Maintain daily and accurate health log records of all occurrences involving the Medic's Office. 9. If time and knowledge permit, instruct Scouts in merit badges and program relating to first aid and medical knowledge. 10. Submit a final report of medical supplies needed and recommendations for next summer. 11. All other duties as assigned.
