<p>Reports to: Wheeled Sports Director</p>		
<p>Objective: To carry out a safe, enjoyable ATV, Mountain Biking, and/or Mountain Boarding program, with a minimum of equipment damage or loss while maintaining high standards of safety.</p>		
<p>Requirements for hire: Should an ATV program be run the director must be in compliance with the Boy Scouts of America's National Camp Accreditation Program Standard SQ-412 or is otherwise able to become compliant with the requirements before the start of the summer camp season.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Be trained by an ATV Safety Institute certified instructor.* <p>Must be in good standing with the Boy Scouts of America, Conquistador Council, and Wehinahpay Mountain Camp. *This can occur during staff week under the instruction of the Wheeled Sports Director.</p>		
<p>Preferences for hire: Experienced in safe mountain biking and safe mountain boarding use.</p>		
<p>Specific Responsibilities:</p>		
<p>The Wheeled Sports Staff will have sufficient knowledge, experience, and training in which to deliver a quality wheeled sports program to campers. Specific responsibilities include:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Offer a quality wheeled sports program which may include the [ATV program], Cycling Merit Badge, and/or mountain board program. 2. Assist in the set-up and take-down of a quality wheeled sports program. 3. Maintain strict discipline at all times when campers, leaders, and other staff are in the area. 4. Participate in all camp-wide activities. 5. Assist in the set-up and take-down of all camp facilities. 6. All other duties as assigned.
