<p><b>Requirements for hire:</b></p>	<p>Must be in compliance with the Boy Scouts of America's National Camp Accreditation Program Standard SQ-409 or is otherwise able to become compliant with the requirements before the start of the summer camp season.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Must have a valid certificate of training from the Director COPE section of National Camping School.</li> </ul> <p>Must be in good standing with the Boy Scouts of America, Conquistador Council, and Wehinahpay Mountain Camp.</p>	
<p><b>Preferences for hire:</b></p>	<p>Extensive climbing and COPE experience.</p>	
<p><b>Specific Responsibilities:</b></p>	<p>The COPE/Climbing Director must be able to teach the Climbing merit badge and Project C.O.P.E. skills to all participants. Specific responsibilities include:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Supervise, train, and motivate the COPE/Climbing staff in all their activities.</li> <li>2. Maintain the high standards of safety and program as set forth in the C.O.P.E. guidebook, Climb-On, and training.</li> <li>3. Maintain strict discipline at all times when campers, leaders, and other staff are in the area.</li> <li>4. Offer a quality COPE/Climbing program that includes the Climbing Merit Badge and Project C.O.P.E. program.</li> <li>5. Direct the set-up and take-down of the climbing tower, C.O.P.E. course, and Aerial Adventure Park under strict adherence to all National Standards regarding Project C.O.P.E. and climbing facilities.</li> <li>6. Represent the COPE/Climbing Area at all area director meetings.</li> <li>7. Maintenance, inventory, security, safety, and wise use of all COPE/Climbing equipment.</li> <li>8. Participate in all camp-wide activities as assigned.</li> <li>9. Make a written advancement report on all COPE/Climbing activities at the end of each week.</li> <li>10. Conduct program staff evaluations for the COPE/Climbing staff as requested and submit a written report on the work of each of the staff at the close of the camp season.</li> <li>11. Submit a complete inventory of all COPE/Climbing equipment and facilities, including condition and recommendations for next year's supplies.</li> <li>12. Assist in the set-up and take-down of all camp facilities.</li> <li>13. All other duties as assigned.</li> </ol>
