<p>Objective: To develop and carry out a quality archery program for campers while maintaining high standards of safety.</p>		
<p>Requirements for hire: Must be in compliance with the Boy Scouts of America’s National Camp Accreditation Program Standard SQ-408 or is otherwise able to become compliant with the requirements before the start of the summer camp season.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The range supervisor shall be a BSA archery rangemaster or USA Archery Level 1 instructor. <p>Must be in good standing with the Boy Scouts of America, Conquistador Council, and Wehinahpay Mountain Camp.</p>		
<p>Preferences for hire: Extensive knowledge and experience in the safe use and education of archery.</p>		
<p>Specific Responsibilities:</p>		
<p>The Shooting Sports Assistant Director – Archery will exhibit proficiency and safety in archery. Specific responsibilities include:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Aid the Shooting Sports Director in the supervision and motivation of the Shooting Sports Staff assigned to the archery range. 2. As assigned, aid the Shooting Sports Director in the training of the Shooting Sports Staff in all their activities pertaining to the archery range. 3. Assume full direction of the archery range in the absence of the Shooting Sports Director, unless otherwise directed. 4. Be familiar with and lead the strict observation of all safety rules and policies for the archery areas. 5. Offer a quality archery program which may include the Archery Merit Badge, open shoot, and sporting arrows. 6. Instruct campers and leaders in the safe handling and usage of archery equipment, including sporting arrows. 7. Assist in the set-up and take-down of a quality archery range. 8. Assist the Shooting Sports Director in the maintenance, inventory, security, safety, and wise use of all archery equipment used in the Shooting Sports Area. 9. Maintain strict discipline at all times when campers, leaders, and other staff are in the area. 10. Participate in all camp-wide activities. 11. Assist in the set-up and take-down of all campsite facilities. 12. All other duties as assigned.
